

## The Packer Group Value-Cards Discussion Questions

<u>Overview</u>: This lively and engaging exercise is designed to engage teams, cross-functional departments, or training classes into a discussion about personal values. This exercise is multifaceted. This can be a high-level and therefore used as an ice-breaker or team building. But the exercise can also be used to explorer a much deeper application both personally and within organizations. **<u>Purpose</u>**: By the end of this exercise participants will have indentified and discussed their own values as well as their co-workers / colleagues.

## **Discussion Questions**

After the completing Step 5 (instructions can be found at <a href="www.thepackergroup.com/valuecards">www.thepackergroup.com/valuecards</a>) and when participants have shared their top 3 values, the following questions can be used to continue the discussion:

- 1. How would you <u>feel</u> if someone in the work environment asked you do something that violated your top values?
- 2. How would you <u>react</u> if someone in the work environment asked you do something that violated your top values?
- 3. Have you ever asked some to do something that violated their top values?
- 4. How many people in the class / session share the exact same top 3 values?
- 5. How many people in the class / session have at least one value that overlaps with someone else?
- 6. Does the organization have values that are consistent with anyone's top 3 personal values? If so, how does it feel to work in that environment? If not, how does it feel to work in that environment?
- 7. How does knowing your colleague's values help you work with them?
- 8. If you have a staff, do you know the values of each direct report? What would be the benefits of knowing your staff's values?
